Re: MARSHALL DRIVE RECONSTRUCTION

Dear Marshall Drive Residents,


Please be advised that the Borough of West Chester is reconstructing and resurfacing Marshall Drive from Franklin Street to Goshen Road. Our contractor, **EJ Breneman has informed us that the road construction is scheduled to begin Friday, September 16th.**

The road base will be reconstructed using a method called Cold In-place Recycling, which grinds up, improves and re-uses the existing road materials. Following approximately ten days of curing time the road base will be resurfaced with a final wearing course. The base recycling activity may take two to three days, and the resurfacing may take an additional two to three days to complete. Local residents will be allowed to pass through the work area with caution.

There may be some inconvenience while the daily work is in progress, and we will ask you to remove your vehicles from the street during the day. Parking will be available after each work day. Please be alert for temporary "No Parking" signs, which we will place as the work begins and continues.
